


Machu Picchu

CIRCUIT 1-A: Machu Picchu Mountain




This ticket includes a visit to the upper terrace of Machu Picchu, where you'll reach the Guardian's House and take the iconic postcard photo of the citadel. It also includes the hike to the summit of Machu Picchu Mountain, a round-trip trek of approximately 4 hours. Along the way, you'll be surrounded by lush vegetation — perfect for trekking lovers of all ages.

Duration: 6 hoursDifficulty: Intermediate

Restrictions: No restrictions
 Availability: Year-round

• Schedule: 2 time slots – 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.

CIRCUIT 1-B: Upper Terrace



With this ticket, you'll be able to explore the upper terrace, where you can take the classic postcard photo of Machu Picchu.

You'll also visit the Guardian's House area and stay on the esplanade to capture the best panoramic views of Machu Picchu.

Restrictions: No restrictionsAvailability: Year-round

• Schedule: 10 time slots, from 6:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.



CIRCUIT 1-C: Inti Punku Gate (High season only)



With this ticket, you'll not only explore the upper terrace of Machu Picchu and take the classic postcard photo from the Guardian's House area, but also enjoy a 2-hour hike (round trip) to the Sun Gate, or Intipunku — a site once used by the Incas to observe the winter solstice.


Duration: 4 hoursDifficulty: Easy

• **Restrictions:** No restrictions

• Availability: High season only (June 1st to October

• Schedule: 4 time slots, from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

CIRCUIT 1-D: Inca Bridge (High season only)



On this route, you'll be able to see the Inca Bridge, built with stone and wood, as well as enjoy views of the beautiful Vilcanota Valley.

The round-trip hike is approximately 2 km and requires moderate physical effort. This route is available during the high season only.

Duration: 2.5 hours
Difficulty: Intermediate
Restrictions: No restrictions

• Availability: High season only (June 1st to October

15th)

• Schedule: 4 time slots, from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.





CIRCUIT 2-A: Designed Classic



This circuit is the most complete, as it covers most of Machu Picchu and offers the classic photo of the site from a platform below the Guardian's House.

You'll explore the interior of Machu Picchu on a walk that lasts no more than 3 hours.

Duration: 3 hoursDifficulty: Easy

Restrictions: No restrictions
 Availability: Year-round

• Schedule: 7 time slots, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

CIRCUIT 2-B: Lower Terrace



This ticket is the second option of Circuit 2. This route is almost identical to Route 2-A, with the only difference being a detour that quickly takes you to the lower terrace of the Guardian's House.

You'll visit important sites such as the Temple of the Condor, the viewpoint of the Temple of the Sun, and more.

Duration: 3 hoursDifficulty: Easy


Restrictions: No restrictionsAvailability: Year-round

CIRCUITO 3-A: Wayna Picchu Mountain



This circuit allows you to visit the lower part of the Inca citadel, as well as take a 3-hour hike (round trip) to the summit of Wayna Picchu Mountain. From the top, you'll enjoy a privileged view of Machu Picchu and explore the archaeological remains

Duration: 4 hours Difficulty: Difficult

• Restrictions: Only for visitors aged 12 and up

• Availability: Year-round

• **Schedule:** 2 time slots – 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.

CIRCUITO 3-B: Designed Royalty



With this ticket, you'll visit enclosures built exclusively for the Inca royalty. Although it does not include the classic Machu Picchu photo, you can still get a similar postcard-like shot from the agricultural sector. The walk lasts approximately 2 hours, during which you'll immerse yourself in the rich history of the Incas.

Duration: 2 hoursDifficulty: Easy

Restrictions: No restrictionsAvailability: Year-round

• Schedule: 7 time slots, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.





CIRCUITO 3-C: Great Cavern (High season only)



This ticket grants access to exclusive areas of Machu Picchu, such as the Temple of the Condor, the Water Mirrors, the Twelve Niches, the Sacred Rock, and more. You'll also visit the mysterious Temple of the Moon, a structure built inside a natural cave on the slopes of Wayna Picchu Mountain.

Along this route, you can take photos from the mid-level or during the descent.


Duration: 3 hoursDifficulty: Difficult

• Restrictions: Only for visitors aged 12 and up

• Availability: High season only (June 1st to October 15th

• Schedule: 2 time slots, from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.

CIRCUITO 3-D: Huchuy Picchu Mountain (High season only)



With this ticket, in addition to exploring the Inca royalty sector, you'll be able to hike to the summit of Huchuy Picchu Mountain — the small mountain next to Wayna Picchu. However, it does not include the classic Machu Picchu photo. Along this route, you can take pictures from the mid-section or on the way down.

Duration: 3 hoursDifficulty: Easy

• Restrictions: No restrictions

• Availability: High season only (June 1st to October 15th)

• Schedule: 2 time slots, from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
